In appropriate cases we would like to report on events from our school life and in doing so also publish personal data in pictures and text, i.e. in addition to class photos, information about school trips, projects and (sports) competitions come into consideration here, for example. The publications should be documentation and appreciation of events and persons and are of a general nature.

The rights to the photos are granted without remuneration and include the right to edit them, as long as the editing is not distorting.

Consent may be revoked at any time in the future in writing to the head teacher. In the case of printed works, consent can no longer be revoked once the print order has been placed.

In the event of revocation, corresponding data will no longer be used for the above-mentioned purposes in the future and will be deleted from the corresponding Internet offerings.

Otherwise, consent for digital publications and their electronic archiving, for example as a photo gallery, is valid for a period of ten years from publication, after which the data will be deleted.

Consent is voluntary. No disadvantages arise from not giving or withdrawing consent. Please discuss with your child how to behave properly when photographs are taken.

You have a right of access to your personal data vis-à-vis the school, a right to rectification, deletion or restriction, a right to object to processing and a right to data portability. You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the data protection supervisory authority, the Berlin Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information.

Publications on the internet / data protection notice:

When published on the internet, personal data (including photos) can be accessed and stored worldwide. This data can thus also be found via search engines and used with other available data for profiling by third parties.
